- Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicants must be a member of the Historical Society, or have an immediate family member who is a member of the Society.

The Scholarship Program is facilitated and managed by the Washington County Historical Society Board of Directors and administered by a designated committee.

- Two letters of reference.
- Signed transcript from your school.
- Letter describing why you are interested in historic preservation or interpretation, and how you intend to incorporate it into your academic and/or career plans.
